## Theatre Camp

The Sage Studio Theatre Camp is an intensive three week course for ages 11-18 with an emphasis on building ensemble unity, individual acting development, vocal enhancement and stage movement. There will be a final showcase presented at the end of the three weeks that is created by the students and their instructors.

Participants will write, act and direct. They will take classes and have an opportunity to explore their own vision in a creative, supportive environment. This camp will provide essential skills that can help a child in the classroom and in the world such as:

- Communication—ideas through voice, action and creative expression
- Problem solving analysis/critical thinking—understanding situations and decision making
- Cooperative learning—teamwork empathy and interaction with peers
- Self-esteem—confidence and responsibility

## Admission

Sage Studio will accept a limited number (maximum 40) of students with multi-faceted interests in playwriting, directing and performing. When selecting students, we look for a proven ability to handle the demands of disciplined work and to be a positive and contributing member of an ensemble. Applicants must demonstrate a determination to complete the program in a conscientious manner. Applicants must submit a single page essay on why they wish to attend the dramatic workshop. Special attention is paid to the student's essay.
