

NAME: *Diary of a Wimpy Kid: The Musical* presented by Raue Center School For The Arts

SEEKING: Non-equity professional actor to audition for the role of GREG HEFFLEY (LEAD) – Any ethnicity. Actor needs to play 11-year-old boy (or at least look that age), first year middle schooler, driven with a burning desire to achieve popularity and acclaim, at any and all costs. Equal parts cocky and insecure, Greg's single-focus on popularity often makes him short-sighted and immature, almost costing him his closest friendship. Seeking strong, comedic young performer with a powerful, unchanged singing voice. *This role carries 98% of the show.*

STIPEND: There will be \$200 stipend for the role.

AUDITIONS: We are currently looking at potential actors to come to callbacks on Monday, March 4 from 6:30 – 7:30 PM. If you cannot make it to the callbacks, we will accept video submissions with a deadline of this Sunday by Noon. **PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL CASTING CONSIDERATIONS WILL BE BASED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST AUDITION BASIS.**

TO PREPARE: We will provide auditioners with materials that will be presented at callbacks (if able to attend callbacks). Otherwise, if submitting a video, auditioners should prepare 16 – 32 bars of a song from a musical. Auditioners are also asked to prepare NO MORE than a 1-minute memorized monologue.

REHEARSAL DATES: March 6 – April 12, 2024 (We are able to work around potential conflicts)

DAYS OF THE WEEK FOR REHEARSAL: Monday thru Thursday with the potential of a few Sundays. Cast members may not be called to every rehearsal based on what is being taught that evening. *(Please note that the final schedule of rehearsal days will be determined by cast conflicts).*
